RULES AND REGULATIONS: USBC RULES WILL APPLY

- Men, Women or Mixed teams may participate.
- Handicap is based on 90% from 225 for each bowler. 225 and over, bowl scratch.
- Bowlers will use their highest USBC average from the 2007-2008 season. If none, use the highest book average from the past 2 seasons in an USBC, ABC or WIBC league. Minimum of 21 games in any season is required to establish an average. Sport league averages may not be used for sanctioned league average purposes. If no average, men use 180 and women use 160. The ten pin rule is in effect.
- It is the bowler's sole responsibility to determine that the average used in the tournament is correct. Failure to use the correct average or make a correction prior to bowling in the tournament may disqualify the score if the submitted average is lower than the actual average. No correction to the final score after the completion of bowling will be made if the average used is higher than submitted. Any falsification of averages will result in forfeiture of entry fee and prize winnings.
- (A) Rule 319c of the USBC Sanctioned Tournament Rules will apply to both men and women bowlers. If requested, bowlers record of tournament scores MUST be submitted by the bowler within 10 days after the date of request to avoid disqualification. (B) Bowlers who have qualified for a prize of \$300 or more in any event in a tournament within the previous 12 months must report his/her winnings, score, position and name and place of the tournament to the Tournament Manager prior to the time of bowling. It is the bowler's responsibility to report his/her scores in any tournament where the prize payment has not been made but in which he/she has qualified for \$300 or more. (C) Bowlers who have received an Association Re-Rate or have been re-rated in other tournaments must report such rerate to the Tournament Manager BEFORE bowling. (D) Rule 319a2 is waived for this tournament.
- (A) Multiple entry is permitted. However, no more than two (2) bowlers on the same team may cash more than once in the prize list. (B) Multiple entry is permitted in the Optional Doubles event, but in no case shall the same individual be permitted to place more than once in the prize list with the same partner. (C) Multiple entry is permitted in the Optional Singles event, but in no case shall the same individual be permitted to place more than once in the prize list.
- Tournament Management will have the right to change lane assignment if there is a mechanical failure which would result in a wait of 10 minutes or more.
- Premature termination of the Tournament brought about by war, national emergency, fire, labor difficulties or other reasons beyond the control of the Tournament Management shall cause the prize list to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled up to the time of termination.
- Tournament Management reserves the right to re-rate any bowler and to accept or reject any bowler prior to bowling. If a bowler refuses to accept a re-rate, his or her entry will be rejected and entry fee will be refunded.
